Day 01/Oct 03 MANILA/ROME

Day 02/Oct 04 ARRIVE ROME, Italy

Arrive in Rome, the Eternal City. Meet our local guide for start of sightseeing. View the Coliseum- site of gladiatorial combats and early Christian martyrdom, Roman Forum, Piazza Navonna, among others. End your tour with a visit to the exquisitely beautiful **Trevi Fountain**. Proceed to your hotel for accommodation. (D)

Day 03/Oct 05 ROME

Start the day with a visit to the **Vatican Museum** to admire the frescoes of Michelangelo at the **Sistine Chapel**. See Greek and Roman antiquities and collections of religious arts. Then to **St. Peter's Basilica**, the most magnificent church in Christendom. Pass by the tomb of Pope John Paul II. Visit the patriarchal basilicas: St John Lateran (nearby is the Scala Santa), Santa Maria Maggiore, St Paul's Outside the Walls. (BD)

Day 04/Oct 06 ROME/SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO

Drive southward to San Giovanni Rotondo. Eucharistic Celebration at the **Shrine of St. Pio** at the Basilica of Our Lady of Grace. Meditate on the life of the miraculous saint, most beloved of confessors, who received the Stigmata – the five wounds of Jesus Christ. Also visit St. Michael's Cave and Grotto for meditation. Overnight here. (BD)

Day 05/Oct 07 SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO/ASSISI

Leave for **LANCIANO** to visit the Church of Eucharistic Miracle. The story behind is heartwarming. Eucharistic Celebration. Continue to Assisi, of the most loved St. Francis. (BD)

Day 06/Oct 08 ASSISI/PISA

Commune in the Basilica, the hub of a religious order devoted to the ideals of humility, forgiveness, simplicity and love for all God's creatures. Hear about monastic life and view priceless frescoes adorning the walls of the church. Nearby is the church wherein lies the incorrupt body of **St. Claire**. Then to **Santa Maria Degli Angeli** Church to see the thornless rose bush and the Porziuncola.

Continue to **Pisa** for pictures of its amazing **Leaning Tower** and impressive **Cathedral**. Good shopping in the open market. (BD)

Day 07/Oct 09 PISA/MONTE CARLO, Monaco/NICE, France

Drive through the renowned Italian and French Riviera and arrive in exhilarating Monte Carlo of the **Principality of Monaco**. You may be lucky if time permits to see the Changing of the Guards at the Grimaldi Palace; visit the **Cathedral** – burial place of Princess Grace and many other Monegasque Royals. How about perfumes at the

factory? Arrive in Nice, a splendid city and home of the rich and famous. (BD)

Day 08/Oct 10 NICE/BARCELONA, Spain

Depart for Barcelona via Montpellier. Arrive in Barcelona, the proud capital of Catalonia. Have paella? (BD)

Day 09/Oct 11 BARCELONA/MONTSERRAT/BARCELONA

Today's highlight is a visit to the **Monastery of Montserrat**, perched high on an awesome mountain range rising from the Catalonian plain. Visit the **Royal Basilica** and pray to the venerated **Black Madonna** which according to tradition, was carved by **St. Luke**. Listen to the singing of the celebrated "Escalonia" by the children's choir, considered to be the oldest in Europe. Back to Barcelona for sightseeing: the Columbus Monument, elegant tree lined **Rambblas** and Plaza de Cataluna, historic buildings along Paseo de Gracia. Marvel at **Gaudi's Sagrada Familia**. (BD)

Day 10/Oct 12 BARCELONA/ZARAGOZA

Drive to **Zaragoza**, historic residence of the former kings of Aragon. Visit the huge Basilica of the miraculous **Nuestra Senora del Pilar**. Free time for private devotion in time of the Feast of Nuestra Senora del Pilar. (BD)

Day 11/Oct 13 ZARAGOZA/MADRID

Leave for Madrid, one of the most beautiful cities in the world: imposing, elegant! Drive past the fabulous **Royal Palace**, one of the most impressive palaces in the world. See Puerta del Sol, **Plaza Espana** with its monument to Cervantes, the Parliament, then to the grand **Cibeles Fountain** plus imposing Alcala. Rest of the afternoon is at leisure. (BD)

Day 12/Oct 14 MADRID/FATIMA, Portugal

Continue to Fatima, Portugal passing along the quaint countryside full of olive orchards. Participate at the evening procession. (BD)

Day 13/Oct 15 FATIMA

Participate at the morning Eucharistic Celebration. Drop your petitions in the chapel. Pray the Rosary as you wend your way through the significant places of interest. Visit the humble homes of the visionaries and realize their humble living then. Pass by the miraculous fountain. Pray at the Fatima Shrine (Cova de Iria), the Basilica with tombs of the visionaries and the **Chapel of Apparition**. Excellent shopping of religious souvenirs. Your chance to taste Portuguese specialties. (BD)

Day 14/Oct 16 FATIMA/BURGOS, Spain

Drive to the university city of Salamanca, a "Cultural Capital of Europe". Short orientation. Drive up to the picturesque hills of Spain and arrive at BURGOS, the home of "EL CID" and capital of Old

Castille in the Middle Ages. It was once a seat of the government of the Dictator Franco. (BD)

Day 15/Oct 17 BURGOS/LOYOLA/LOURDES, France

Depart for Loyola. Pray at the Basilica. The Museum will impress you. It was in Loyola that Our Lady appeared to St. Ignatius with the Christ Child. The profound conversion began. Later in life, St. Ignatius renounced his portion of the family's wealth, wrote the famous book of Spiritual Exercises and became the founder of the Jesuit Order. Celebrate Mass here. Continue to Lourdes. After dinner, spend some time for private devotion at the Grotto.(BD)

Day 16/Oct 18 LOURDES

Eucharistic Celebration. Drop your petitions. You may wish to bathe in the miraculous water. You'll be immensely inspired by the humble life of Saint Bernadette. Perhaps watch a movie on her life. Pray collectively the life-size Stations of the Cross in its most magnificent setting. Witness the Blessing and Procession of the Sick! Now meditate at the Grotto for a close communication with God. (BD)

Day 17/Oct 19 LOURDES/PARIS

Depart for Paris via the TGV fast train. Enjoy a delightful cruise along the River Seine passing by majestic landmarks.(BD)

Day 18/Oct 20 PARIS

Morning visit to the **Shrine of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal** where you'll pray afterwards before the incorrupt body of **St. Catherine Laboure**. See the **Cathedral of Notre Dame**, one of the greatest Gothic churches in the world with its magnificent stained glass windows. Also see the majestic Arc de Triomphe, Champs Elysee, Place de Concorde, one of the most admired plazas in the world. Go up to the **Eiffel Tower** for a scenic view of the loveliest city in the world. Another night in Paris. (BD)

Day 19/Oct 21 PARIS/BRUSSELS, Belgium
AMSTERDAM, The Netherlands

Drive to Brussels, capital of Belgium and "European Capital of Culture". View the **Grand Platz** of magnificent Middle Age buildings with the towering **Town Hall** opposite the **House of Kings**. This is verily the most impressive plaza in the world! Why don't you try "Mussels in Brussels" lunch today. Photo op at the **Atomium mode**, symbol of the Brussels World Expo. Continue to Amsterdam, another "European Capital of Culture" for the night. (BD)

Day 20/Oct 22 AMSTERDAM

Start the day with sightseeing along quaint canals and bridges, gable houses, **Dam Square**, the **Palace** and other interesting sites. Visit a diamond factory of which Holland is noted for. Visit the De Simonehoeve **Cheese Farm and Clog Factory**. What an exhilarating experience! Enjoy a showcase of the Amsterdam riverbanks on a **canal cruise**. (BD)

Day 21/Oct 23 AMSTERDAM/MANILA

Visit **Aalsmer**, flower capital of the world. Flowers from all over the world – Europe, Ecuador, Colombia, Ethiopia, Kenya and other countries are traded everyday in a gigantic building. Have some free time here, before we continue to the airport for your flight back home. (B)

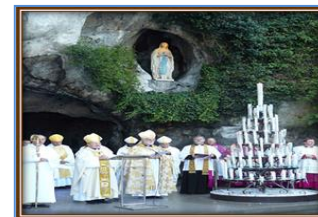

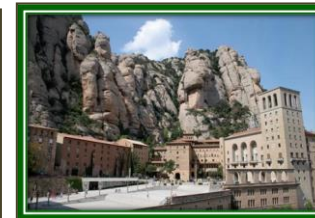
