**Day 01/Oct 07 MANILA/ROME**

**Day 02/Oct 08 ARRIVE ROME, Italy**

Arrive in Rome, the Eternal City. Meet our local guide for start of sightseeing. View the Coliseum- site of gladiatorial combats and early Christian martyrdom, Roman Forum, Piazza Navonna, among others. End your tour with a visit to the exquisitely beautiful **Trevi Fountain**. Proceed to your hotel for accommodation. (D)

**Day 03/Oct 09 ROME**

Continue with a visit to the Vatican Museum to admire the frescoes of Michelangelo at the Sistine Chapel. See Greek and Roman antiquities and collections of religious arts. Drive southward to San Giovanni Rotondo. Eucharistic Celebration at the Shrine of St. Pio at the Basilica of Our Lady of Grace. Meditate on the life of the miraculous saint, most beloved of confessors, who received the Stigmata – the five wounds of Jesus Christ. Overnight here. (B/D)

**Day 05/Oct 11 SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO/ASSISI**

Leave for **LANCIANO** to visit the Church of Eucharistic Miracle. The story behind is heartwarming. Eucharistic Celebration. Continue to Assisi, of the most loved St. Francis. (B/D)

**Day 06/Oct 12 ASSISI/PISA**

Commune in the Basilica, the hub of a religious order devoted to the ideals of humility, forgiveness, simplicity and love for all God's creatures. Hear about monastic life and view priceless frescoes adorning the walls of the church. Nearby is the church wherein lies the incorrupt body of **St. Claire**. Then to **Santa Maria Degli Angeli** Church to see the thornless rose bush and the Porziuncola.

Continue to **Pisa** for pictures of its amazing **Leaning Tower** and impressive **Cathedral**. Good shopping in the open market. (B/D)

**Day 07/Oct 13**

**PISA/MONTE CARLO, Monaco/NICE, France**

Drive through the renowned Italian and French Riviera and arrive in exhilarating Monte Carlo of the **Principality of Monaco**. You may be lucky if time permits to see the Changing of the Guards at the Grimaldi Palace; visit the **Cathedral** – burial place of Princess Grace and many other Monegasque Royals. How about perfumes at the

factory? Arrive in Nice, a splendid city and home of the rich and famous. (B/D)

**Day 08/Oct 14 NICE/BARCELONA, Spain**

Depart for Barcelona via Montpellier. Arrive in Barcelona, the proud capital of Catalonia. Have paella? (B/D)

**Day 09/Oct 15 BARCELONA/MONTSERRAT/BARCELONA**

Today's highlight is a visit to the **Monastery of Montserrat**, perched high on an awesome mountain range rising from the Catalanian plain. Visit the **Royal Basilica** and pray to the venerated **Black Madonna** which according to tradition, was carved by **St. Luke**. Listen to the singing of the celebrated "Escalonia" by the children's choir, considered to be the oldest in Europe. Back to Barcelona for sightseeing: the Columbus Monument, elegant tree lined **Ramblas** and Plaza de Catalunya, historic buildings along Paseo de Gracia. Marvel at **Gaudi's Sagrada Familia**. (B/D)

**Day 10/Oct 16 BARCELONA/ZARAGOZA/MADRID**

Drive to **Zaragoza**, historic residence of the former kings of Aragon. Visit the huge Basilica of the miraculous **Nuestra Senora del Pilar**. Arrive in Madrid for the night. (B/D)

**Day 11/Oct 17 MADRID/AVILA**

Start to Madrid for sightseeing. Madrid, one of the most beautiful cities in the world: imposing, elegant! Visit the fabulous **Royal Palace**, one of the most impressive palaces in the world. Visit Puerta del Sol, **Plaza Espana** with its monument to Cervantes, view the Parliament, then to the grand **Cibeles Fountain** plus imposing Alcala.

Drive to the walled city of mystic Avila. Hear about the life of St. Teresa, Doctor of the Church and one of the greatest figures in Church history. Eucharistic Celebration. (B/D)

**Day 12/Oct 18 AVILA/FATIMA, Portugal**

Leave for Fatima, Portugal passing along the quaint countryside full of olive orchards. Participate at the evening procession. (B/D)

**Day 13/Oct 19 FATIMA**

Participate at the morning Eucharistic Celebration. Drop your petitions in the chapel. Pray the Rosary as you wend your way through the significant places of interest. Visit the humble homes of the visionaries and realize their humble living then. Pass by the miraculous fountain. Pray at the Fatima Shrine (Cova de Iria), the Basilica with tombs of the visionaries and the **Chapel of Apparition**. Excellent shopping of religious souvenirs. Your chance to taste Portuguese specialties. (B/D)

**Day 14/Oct 20 FATIMA/BURGOS, Spain**

Drive to the university city of Salamanca, a "Cultural Capital of Europe". Short orientation. Drive up to the picturesque hills of Spain and arrive at BURGOS, the home of "EL CID" and capital of Old Castille in the Middle Ages. It was once a seat of the government of the Dictator Franco. (B/D)

**Day 15/Oct 21 BURGOS/LOYOLA/LOURDES, France**

Depart for Loyola. Pray at the Basilica. The Museum will impress you. It was in Loyola that Our Lady appeared to St. Ignatius with the Christ Child. The profound conversion began. Later in life, St. Ignatius renounced his portion of the family's wealth, wrote the famous book of Spiritual Exercises and became the founder of the Jesuit Order. Celebrate Mass here. Continue to Lourdes. After dinner, spend some time for private devotion at the Grotto. (B/D)

**Day 16/Oct 22 LOURDES**

Eucharistic Celebration. Drop your petitions. You may wish to bathe in the miraculous water. You'll be immensely inspired by the humble life of Saint Bernadette. Perhaps watch a movie on her life. Pray collectively the life-size Stations of the Cross in its most magnificent setting. Witness the Blessing and Procession of the Sick! Now meditate at the Grotto for a close communication with God. (B/D)

**Day 17/Oct 23 LOURDES/PARIS**

Depart for Paris via the TGV fast train. Enjoy a delightful cruise along the River Seine passing by majestic landmarks. (B/D)

**Day 18/Oct 24 PARIS**

Morning visit to the **Shrine of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal** where you'll pray afterwards before the incorrupt body of **St. Catherine Laboure**. See the **Cathedral of Notre Dame**, one of the greatest Gothic churches in the world with its magnificent stained glass windows. Also see the majestic Arc de Triomphe, Champs Elysee, Place de Concorde, one of the most admired plazas in the world. Go up to the **Eiffel Tower** for a scenic view of the loveliest city in the world. Another night in Paris. (B/D)

**Day 19/Oct 25 PARIS**

The day is at leisure until transfer to the airport for your flight back home. (B)

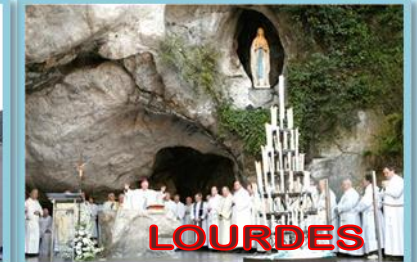
