Jan 24/Day 01 MANILA/DELHI

Arrive in Delhi. See and marvel at the Indira Gandhi International Airport, the world's 8th largest passenger terminal and the world's 4th best airport in 2010. Meet and check in at the hotel.

Jan 25/Day 02 DELHI

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Morning visit to the famous **Akshardham temple**. The monument is a fusion of several architectural styles of Pink stone and pure white marble. This was built by over 3,000 volunteers and 7,000 artisans to complete this complex display of traditional Indian and Hindu Culture. Later visit the **Lotus (Bahai) temple** followed by a visit to the **Qutab Minar**, a Tower of Victory that was built in the 12th century Qutab-ud-din Aibak. Drive past the **India gate** (war memorial dedicated to the lives of Indian Soldiers), then to the President's residence -formerly the Viceroy's Palace, Parliament House and the Secretariat buildings of Victorian vintage.

In the afternoon visit the **Old Delhi** driving past the magnificent **Red Fort**, a World Heritage site. Walk through the **Chandni of Chowk** to savor the ambiance of an oriental bazaar. Enjoy a short rickshaw ride through the narrow lanes of Old Delhi to reach **Jama Masjid**- the largest mosque in India. Evening , enjoy “ **Dances of India** “ show which showcased various dance forms that exists in different parrrts of India followed by dinner at Chor Bazaar restaurant. (B,L,D)

Jan 26/Day 03 DELHI/AGRA

Buffet breakfast at the hotel. In the morning, witness **India's Republic Day Parade**. This annual Grand Parade is composed of different regiments of the army in all their finery and official decorations followed by costumed horses, camels and elephants and colorful floats. Marching contingents from all over India outdo each other in color and pageantry.

In the afternoon, drive to Agra visiting the **Iskon Temple** dedicated to **Lord Krishna and Mathura**. Places of interest include **Vishram Ghat** on the river Yamuna, Shri Krishna Janna Bhumi, the birth place of **Lord Krishna and Government Museum** located at Dampier Park. Check in at the hotel . (B,L,D)

27 Jan/Day 04 AGRA

After breakfast at the hotel, visit Agra. See the world's famous **Taj Mahal**, situated on the banks of the river Yamuna. The **Taj Mahal** is an epitome of love, a poem in marble by the Mughal Emperor Shahjehan for his beloved queen Mumtaz Mahal. This new 7th Wonder of the World is the loveliest mausoleum of the world which took 22 years to build.

Visit **Mahtab Bagh**, situated on the sandy bank of Yamuna River just opposite the Taj Mahal mausoleum. The place provides a picturesque view of the Taj Mahal.

Proceed to **Agra Fort** – built by Emperor Akbar and beautified with palaces and gardens by Jehangir. Also visit the **Church and Orphanage** run by **Missionaries** of Charity of Mother Teresa. (B,L,D)

28Jan/Day 05 AGRA/FATEPHUSIKRI/BHARATPUR

Drive to **Fatehpur Sikri (the City of Victory)**: built during the second half of the 16th century by Emperor Akbar. The complex monuments and temples all in a uniform architectural style, includes one of the largest mosques in India, the **Jama Masjid**. The finest monuments within this

area are the **Diwan - i – Am, Diwan - i – Khas, Panch Mahal, Jama Masjid, Panch Mahal, Buland Darwaza** and the tomb of **Saint Sheikh Salim Christi**. Check in at the hotel. (B,L,D)

29 Jan/Day 06 BHARATPUR/ABANERI/JAIPUR

After breakfast, drive to Jaipur and visit **Abaneri**. Enjoy a camel ride through the village of Abhaneri .Visit the **Abhaneri step well**, one of India's deepest and largest step wells (also known as tank gardens). After lunch at the camp in Abhaneri, continue your drive to Jaipur and check-in at the hotel. (B,L,D)

30 Jan/Day 07 JAIPUR

After early breakfast proceed to **Galtaji and Milk Market**. **Jaipur Galtaji** is a holy place in India where St. Galay spent his life meditating.

In the afternoon, proceed to Amber Fort , it is a classic romantic Rajasthani Fort Palace. Have the tour of the “ Pink City “ the surroundings all painted in pink to commemorate the arrival of a British monarch. Visit the City Palace, the principal residence of the ruling family , known for its stunning architecture . Thorough the slitted windows, the Maharajah concubines peek to see the goings on below. In the evening enjoy Dinner with cultural folk dance show. (B,L,D)

31 Jan/Day 08 JAIPUR/DELHI/MANILA

After breakfast, transfer back to Delhi . Transfer to airport for flight back to Manila. (B,L,D)
