

This is the most affordable tour of memorable places led by an impressive Dominican priest.

Day 01/Sep 06 MANILA/PARIS

Day 02/Sep 07 PARIS, France

Arrive in Paris, romantic capital of Europe. After immigration and customs formalities, proceed to the city. Enjoy a delightful cruise along the River Seine passing by majestic landmarks. (D)

Day 03/Sep 08 PARIS

Eucharistic Celebration at the **Shrine of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal** where you'll pray afterwards before the incorrupt body of St. Catherine Laboure. Proceed to sightseeing. Visit the Cathedral of Notre Dame, one of the greatest Gothic churches in the world with its magnificent stained glass windows. See the majestic Arc de Triomphe, Champs Elysees, Place de Concorde, one of the most admired plazas in the world. Up to the second level of Eiffel Tower, up, up for a scenic view of the loveliest city in the world.

Visit a Fragonard Perfume Museum, France has been a world center of the perfume industry since the 17th century. Have time to visit Galleries La Fayette, the biggest store in Europe. Rest of the day is at leisure. (BD)

Day 04/Sep 09 PARIS/LISIEUX/PARIS

Drive to picturesque Lisieux, home of St. Therese of the Little Flower. St. Therese whom Pope Pius X called "the greatest saint of modern times". Her extraordinary love for God and devotion to humanity come alive as you visit the very impressive Basilica of St. Peter, the museum containing her relics and Les Buissonets, her family home. Combine your prayers in the Carmel chapel with those of the Carmelite sisters, just as St. Therese did before her death in 1897. Eucharistic Celebration. Back to Paris for another night. (BD)

Day 05/Sep 10 PARIS/NEVERS/LYON

Drive to **NEVERS**. Visit the **Monastery of St. Gildard**. View the incorrupt body of St. Bernadette and pray at her favorite spots in the garden.

Continue to **PARAY LE MONIAL**, where you may attend a Eucharistic Celebration at the chapel where the Sacred Heart of Jesus appeared to **St. Margaret Alacoque**. Her incorrupt body lies at the side altar. Remember the promises of the Sacred Heart?

Continue to **ARS**, a small city northwest of Lyon. Pray and visit the Shrine of St. John Vianney, patron saint of parish priests. Spend the night in Lyon. (BD)

Day 06/Sep 11 LYON/LA SALETTE/AVIGNON

Drive to the hilly **LA SALETTE**, where the Virgin Mary appeared to young shepherd children. Private devotion to the Blessed Mother at the apparition site. You'll be amazed at pilgrims praying as they walk across the hill.

Continue driving towards Avignon, a city in southeastern France's Provence region, set on the Rhone River. Sightseeing will include a visit to the Palace of the Popes. From 1309 to 1377, it was the seat of the Catholic popes. It remained under papal rule until becoming part of France in 1791. This legacy can be seen in the massive **Palais des Papes** (Popes' Palace) in the city center, which is surrounded by medieval stone ramparts. See **Saint Benezet Bridge**, listed as World Heritage site by UNESCO. View the Royal Palace, Street of Dyers, Temple Saint Martial, Notre Dame Cathedral and Avignon Synagogue. Spend the night here. (BD)

Day 07/Sep 12 AVIGNON/TOULOUSE/LOURDES

Leave for Toulouse, half way between the Atlantic and the Mediterranean. Toulouse is the fourth largest city in France, after Paris, Marseille and Lyon. Toulouse is a city committed to its graceful past centuries, boasting fine medieval architecture such as the 11th century **Basilica Saint Sernin** and Pont-Neuf (New Bridge) a recently constructed beauty arching in graceful stonework across the Garonne River. Drive past **Jardin des Plantes** botanical gardens.

Continue to Lourdes. After dinner, you may stay at the Grotto for prayer and private devotions. (BD)

Day 08/Sep 13 LOURDES

Eucharistic Celebration. Drop your petitions. You may wish to bathe in the miraculous water. You'll be immensely inspired by the humble life of Saint Bernadette. Perhaps watch a movie on her life. Pray collectively before the life-size Stations of the Cross in its most magnificent setting. Witness the Blessing and Procession of the Sick! Now meditate at the Grotto for a close communication with God. (BD)

Day 09/Sep 14 LOURDES/SAN SEBASTIAN/BILBAO, Spain

Drive to San Sebastian, a resort town on the Bay of Biscay in Spain's mountainous Basque country. It is known for its beaches. Sightseeing and Eucharistic Celebration here. Continue to Bilbao, capital of the Basque republic. Proceed to sightseeing including a visit at the iconic **Guggenheim Museum**. Spend the night here. (BD)

Day 10/Sep 15 BILBAO/SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

A scenic drive along Camino Route to Santiago de Compostela. the world's third traditional pilgrimage center and "Cultural Capital of Europe". During medieval times, thousands of pilgrims from all over Europe trekked on foot to this center of miracles. There's a distinct mystic ambiance around you'll evidently feel. A most impressive **Cathedral** stands over where the tomb of the **Apostle St. James** was discovered. Since the discovery of his tomb, numerous petitions have been favorably reported here. Eucharistic Celebration. (BD)

Day 11/Sep 16 SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA/FATIMA, Portugal

Drive to **COIMBRA**, city that houses the oldest university of Portugal. Walk through the streets of Coimbra, until the Convent of the Carmelites, where has lived and died Sister Lucia, one of the little shepherds of Fatima. Continue to Fatima for the night. (BD)

Day 12/Sep 17 FATIMA

Participate at the morning Eucharistic Celebration. Drop your petitions in the chapel. Pray the Rosary as you wend your way through the significant places of interest. Visit the humble homes of the visionaries and realize their humble living then. Pass by the miraculous fountain. Pray at the Fatima Shrine (Cova de Iria), the Basilica with tombs of the visionaries and the **Chapel of Apparition**. Excellent shopping of religious souvenirs. Your chance to taste Portuguese specialties. Rest of the day is for private devotions (BD)

Day 13/Sep 18 FATIMA/SANTAREM/LISBON

Depart to **Santarem**, one of the oldest cities in the world. Walk through its narrow streets to the Church of St. Stephen, containing the oldest recorded Eucharistic miracle. Continue to Lisbon capital of Portugal. Lisbon is a city of pastel colors and cobblestone streets, of vistas and monuments. Visit the **Jeronimos Monastery** and the **Belem Tower** (exterior) both good examples of the 16th century Manueline style, and finally the **Monument to the Discoveries**. (BD)

Day 14/Sep 19 LISBON/MANILA

Eucharistic Celebration at St. Anthony's Church. Remember St. Anthony, one of the few doctors of the church, was born here. Continue to the airport for your flight back home. (B)
