Day 01/Sep 01 MANILA/DUBROVNIK

Day 02/Sep 02 DUBROVNIK, Croatia

Arrive in Dubrovnik, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. If the Dalmatian Coast is the zenith of the Mediterranean, Dubrovnik is the jewel in the crown! Sightseeing in the Old Town ringed by a wall with its stone-paved streets inside the 16th century bastion. See Onofrio's Fountain and the Rector's Palace as well as the Franciscan and Dominican monasteries. (D)

**Day 03/Sep 03 DUBROVNIK/KOTOR, Montenegro
MEDJUGORJE, Bosnia Herzegovina**

Cross the border to Montenegro and take a scenic drive alongside Lake Skadar to the Montenegrin coast. Visit the World Heritage Site of Kotor – a town which was inhabited from the times of the Illyrians and the Romans. Our walk through the city takes us back to medieval times, as most of the monuments we observe are from the 14th to 18th century. Nearly three miles long it is considered one of the world's historic values. Drive along the picturesque Adriatic and arrive in Medjugorje, a place hallowed by the Blessed Virgin Mary. (BD)

Day 04/Sep 04 MEDJUGORJE

You may opt to climb and pray the Stations of the Cross at Cross Hill or climb the Apparition Hill. In this quaint village, Mary, the Queen of Peace has been appearing since June 24, 1981. The apparitions are continuing. Miracles are still happening. Rosary, prayer, praise singing. Eucharistic Celebration and Blessing of the Sick. This is well into the night. Time for religious souvenirs, reconciliation and contemplation. You may participate at the night services at St. James Church. (BD)

Day 05/Sep 05 MEDJUGORJE/PLITVICE LAKES, Croatia

Leave for Croatia and arrive at Plitvice Lakes, a UNESCO listed Plitvice Lakes National Park and Europe's Nature Wonder. Spend the night in a rustic hotel in the area. (BD)

Day 06/Sep 06

PLITVICE LAKES/LAKE BLEED, Slovenia

Tour the park, a wonderland of 16 lakes flanked by thundering waterfalls and primeval forest. Visit Korana Canyon's 230 foot high falls and Tomicevo Pogledalo over the Park. Continue to Slovenia and arrive in lovely Lake Bled. You're in for a romantic setting you'll relish throughout your life. Spend the night here. (BD)

Day 07 /Sep 07 LAKE BLEED & POSTJONA CAVE

Take a traditional boat ride in the romantic lake to the idyllic church on Bled Island. A dream will come true by ringing the wishing bell in the miraculous chapel. Visit the imposing castle on a hill with a panoramic view towering over the lake. What a majestic view! Continue to Postjona, the mysterious underworld of caves, most famous in the world, a UNESCO Heritage Site. Another night in Lake Bled. (BD)

Day 08/Sep 08 LAKE BLEED/TRIESTE/PADOVA, Italy

Drive to Italy with a stop in scenic Trieste. Continue to Padova for a visit to the Church of St. Anthony. Mark that St. Anthony in his life was noted for his eloquent homilies; thus the relic of his tongue is venerated here. Spend the night here. (BD)

Day 09/Sep 09 PADOVA/TURIN/NICE, France

Leave for Turin for a visit at the Duomo San Giovanni where the Holy Shroud is enshrined. Perhaps this is the most holy of relics connected with the passion of Jesus Christ. Meditation. Continue to Nice, a splendid city and home of the rich and famous. You'll be awed by the impressive buildings lining the seashore. Nice for a stroll. (B,D)

Day 10/Sep 10 NICE/LOURDES

The day will be spent driving to Lourdes. Little by little snow appears. After dinner participate at the most moving and inspiring candlelight procession. (BD)

Day 11/Sep 11 LOURDES

Eucharistic Celebration. Drop your petitions. You may wish to bathe in the miraculous water. You'll be immensely inspired by the humble life of Saint Bernadette. Perhaps watch a movie on her life. Pray collectively before the life-size Stations of the Cross in its most magnificent setting. Witness the Blessing and Procession of the Sick! Now meditate at the Grotto for a close communication with God. (BD)

Day 12/Sep 12 LOURDES/BILBAO, Spain

A scenic drive to Bilbao, capital of the Basque Republic. Proceed to sightseeing including a photo stop at the iconic Guggenheim Museum. Spend the night here. (BD)

Day 13/Sep 13 BILBAO/SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

Head towards **Santiago de Compostela**, the world's third traditional pilgrimage center and "Cultural Capital of Europe". (BD)

Day 14/Sep 14

SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA/FATIMA, Portugal

During medieval times, thousands of pilgrims from all over Europe trekked on foot to this center of miracles. There's a distinct mystic ambiance around you'll evidently feel. A most impressive **Cathedral** stands over where the tomb of the **Apostle St. James** was discovered. Since the discovery of his tomb, numerous petitions have been favorably reported here. Eucharistic Celebration. Continue to Fatima for the night. Participate at the evening procession. (BD)

Day 15/Sep 15 FATIMA

Participate at the morning Eucharistic Celebration in time for the 100th Apparition of the Blessed Mary in Fatima. Drop your petitions in the chapel. Pray the Rosary as you wend your way through the significant places of interest. Visit the humble homes of the visionaries and realize their humble living then. Pass by the miraculous fountain. Pray at the Fatima Shrine (Cova de Iria), the Basilica with tombs of the visionaries and the **Chapel of Apparition**. Excellent shopping of religious souvenirs and have a taste of Portuguese specialties. (BD)

Day 16/Sep 16 FATIMA/LISBON

Drive to Lisbon for sightseeing. View Jeronimos Monastery, Belem Tower with the splendid Monument to the Discoverers. Eucharistic Celebration at the Church in honor of **St. Anthony**. Remember St. Anthony, one of the few doctors of the church, was born here. (BD)

Day 17/Sep 17 LISBON/MANILA

Morning at leisure until transfer to the airport for your flight back home. (B)

Day 18/Sep 18 ARRIVE MANILA
