

Day 01 MANILA/BANGKOK

Depart Manila. Arrival in Bangkok meet and check in at airport hotel.

Day 02

BANGKOK/KATHMANDU/NAGARKOT, Nepal

Transfer to the airport for your flight to Kathmandu, capital of Nepal. Proceed to sightseeing. Visit **Bhaktapur Durbar Square**, the **Palace of 55 Windows** built during the period of King Bhupatindra Malla in 1754 . Then proceed to **Nagarkot**, the tiny settlement of Nagarkot clings to a hilltop 36 km east of Kathmandu at an altitude of 2,099m. It is one of the best vantage points to view the peaks- from the Annapurna’s to Everest. Enjoy the beautiful view of sunset over Himalaya from your hotel. (BD)

Day 03

NAGARKOT/PATAN/KATHMANDU/PASHUPATINATH

Early morning enjoy the beautiful view of the changing colours of Himalayas during the sunrise from your hotel. During the sightseeing, you will visit **Patan Durbar Square: Patan** - the ancient city once a kingdom in itself, it is situated across the Bagmati River to the south of Kathmandu. Patan Durbar Square offers the finest display of Newari urban architecture in Nepal. Later proceed to **Kathmandu Durbar Square**; Kathmandu’s number one tourist attraction swarms with life. See the most famous building here is the **Kumari Bahal**, a building richly decorated with beautiful wood carvings and the home to the **Royal Kumari**. (the living Goddess).

Late visit to **Bouddhanath**- the great stupa is one of Nepal’s most distinctive monuments and one of the most important Buddhist sites in Nepal and with a diameter of over 100 meters amongst the largest in the world. Visit **Pashupatinath**, Nepal’s most sacred Hindu shrine and one of the subcontinent’s great Shiva sites. In the evening enjoy the Nepalese Dinner with traditional cultural Show. Overnight in Kathmandu. (B,L,D)

Day 04 KATHMANDU/PARO/THIMPU, Bhutan

Transfer to the airport for your flight to Paro. After immigration and customs formalities, drive to Thimpu for your accommodation. Visit the impressive **Thimphu Dzong** (fortress built in 17th century). Overnight in Thimphu. (B,L,D)

Day 05 THIMPU

Visit the **Memorial Chorten** - built in the memory of the **third King of**

Bhutan reigned from (1952-1972). Visit the National Institute of Traditional Medicine, Nunnery temple, Folk Heritage Museum and the School of Arts and Crafts(painting school). After lunch visit **Kuenselphodrang**-traditional paper factory. Another night in Thimphu.(B,L,D)

Day 06 THIMPU/PUNAKHA

Drive to Punakha takes you over the Dochula pass (3050m). Along the way you will see the Eastern Himalayan ranges (ranging from 6000m to 7500m). Enroute visit the **Chime Lhakhang Monastery**, this famous fertility monastery was built in 15th century. Childless women from all over Bhutan come to this monastery for blessing. It takes about half an hour walk each way through beautiful village and rice paddy field. After lunch, drive to visit the most beautiful **Punakha Dzong** built in 1637. It once served as winter capital of Bhutan and still houses the winter seat for the head of religion and central monastic body. Overnight in Punakha. (B,L,D)

Day 07 PUNAKHA/PARO

Back to Paro over Dochula pass (3050m). Upon arrival visit **Kyichu monastery** built in 7th century. After lunch will be a visit to the national museum, **Paro Ringpung Dzong** built in 1646. If time permits - explore Paro town to do some shopping of souvenirs.. Overnight in Paro. (B,L,D)

Day 08 PARO

Excursion to tigers nest. The excursion to **Tiger Nest** takes about 5 hours round trip. This famous site was visited by **Guru Rinpoche** in the 8th century and meditated in a cave where he left his body imprint on the rock. The site stand as the most holy and sacred in the whole Himalayas. Back to hotel for overnight. (B,L,D)

Day 09 PARO/BANGKOK

Morning is at leisure until transfer to the airport for your flight back to Bangkok. Meet and transfer to hotel for overnight. Rest of the day is at leisure. (B)

Day 10 BANGKOK/MANILA

The day is at leisure until transfer to the airport for your flight back home. (B)






