**Day 01/Feb 15 MANILA/STOCKHOLM**

**Day 02/Feb 16 STOCKHOLM, Sweden**

Arrive in Stockholm, Swedish capital and a cosmopolitan city, if there is one. It is the 1998 "Culture Capital of Europe". Its fantastic location is where Lake Malaren meets the sea, leading to such scenic beauty and royal splendor. (D)

Hotel: Radisson Blu Royal Viking Hotel or similar

**Day 03/Feb 17 STOCKHOLM**

Sightseeing will include a view of the **Royal Palace**, the **Cathedral Riddarholm** (where the Swedish kings are buried) and the festive blue and white chambers in the **Town Hall**. Visit the **City Hall's Golden Room** where the **Nobel Peace Prize** banquets are held. Highlight is a visit to the unique **Vasa Galleon** which gives us a marvelous impression of life on board a naval vessel in the 17<sup>th</sup> century. Then to the charming **Old Town** and the countless channels and bridges that connect the city's many islands. (BLD)

**Day 04/Feb 18 STOCKHOLM/REYKJAVIK, Iceland**

The day is at leisure until transfer to the airport for your flight to Reykjavik, Iceland. Drive to **Selfoss** for the night. (BD)

Hunt for the Northern Lights.

Hotel: Hotel Selfoss or similar

**Day 05/Feb 19 SOUTH SHORE**

We will spend this day exploring the region close to the towering, strato-volcano Eykafallajokull, which is probably the most famous volcano in the world today. Driving along the south shore we will make a stop at the spectacular waterfalls Seljalandsfoss and Skogafoss. Onwards to Reynisfjara beach, viewing the extraordinary rock formations and thundering waves of the Atlantic Ocean. Also visit the Skogar Folk Museum and Selfoss.

You may join an optional SNOWMOBILE RIDE. Spend two nights at a hotel in Klaustur area. (BLD)

**Day 06/Feb 20**

**SKAFTAFELL/**

**JOKULSARLON GLACIAL LAGOON/VIK**

Skaftafell National park is one of Iceland's most outstanding areas of natural beauty dominated by the glacier Vatnajokull, Europe's largest ice cap. Continue to Jokulsarlon Glacial Lagoon where you can enjoy a breathtaking sight of floating icebergs on the fantastic 180m deep glacial lagoon. Just a perfect place to experience Ice and Fire! Spend the night in Vik. (BLD)

Hotel: Icelandair Hotel or similar

**Day 07/Feb 21 VIK/GOLDEN CIRCLE/REYKJAVIK**

Start the day by visit Thingvellir National park (UNESCO) where the world's oldest parliament met for centuries on the shores of Iceland's largest lake. Then we continue through farmland areas to the geothermal fields of Geysir with bubbling mud pools and high spouting Strokkur hot spring. Visit the dramatic two-tiered Gullfoss waterfall, a spectacular sight in winter when frozen mid-cascade. Continue to Reykjavik for the night. (BLD)

Hotel: Grand Hotel Reykjavik or similar

**Day 08/Feb 22 INTO THE GLACIER**

Welcome to the glacier wonderland! This is an unmissable opportunity to see the majestic world inside the heart of Langjokull glacier with your own eyes, 2500 years of ice sculpted by the hand of nature. Here, a monster truck will be waiting to transfer you to the entrance of the tunnel, situated at 1200m above sea level. Also visit many beautiful sites on the way like lava fields, Hraunfossar waterfalls, Halldmundarhraun lava field and hot springs. Another night in Reykjavik. (BLD)

**Day 09/Feb 23 BLUE LAGOON and REYKJAVIK**

On to the Rekjanes peninsula where we enjoy a dip in the famous Blue Lagoon which is a unique wonder of nature with pleasantly warm mineral rich geothermal water in a middle of a black lava field.

After lunch, drive back to the city for sightseeing. Reykjavik is affectionately called the Biggest Little City in the World. On this sightseeing tour you will explore Reykjavik's top attractions, interesting facts and stories that relate to history and culture in Iceland. Enjoy spectacular views from the platforms at **Perlan**, which is built on the city's hot water tanks. You will see Reykjavik's seafont to the old **Hofdi** house where the all-important summit between former U.S. President Ronald Reagan and former U.S.S.R. Secretary General Mikhail Gorbachev took place in 1986. You will then proceed to visit **Hallgrímskirkja** church whose design was inspired by basalt lava columns, a common volcanic rock formation in Icelandic nature. Last but not least you will explore the old town center with the Icelandic parliament **Althingi** and the town hall. (BLD)

**Day 10/Feb 24 REYKJAVIK/OSLO, Norway**

Transfer to the airport for your flight to Oslo, capital of Norway. Rest of the afternoon is at leisure. (BL)

Hotel: Radisson Blue Plaza Hotel Oslo or similar

**Day 11/Feb 25 OSLO/COPENHAGEN (cruise)**

Sightseeing will include a view of the **Akerhus Castle**, the **Royal Palace** and its **City Hall**. See the unique **Viking Ships** in the Museum. Photo view of the **Holmenkollen Ski Jump** and a panoramic view of Oslo City. Marvel at the unique **Vigeland Sculpture Park**. Embark on an overnight cruise to Denmark. Dinner and entertainment on board. (BLD)

**Day 12/Feb 26 COPENHAGEN, Denmark**

Arrive in Copenhagen, "1996 Culture Capital of Europe". Sightseeing includes a view of the Stock Exchange, the medieval **Cathedral**, **Amalienborg Palace** (center of the Danish monarchy) and **Christianborg Palace**. Complete the day with seeing Hans Christian Andersen's **Little Mermaid**, gazing across the harbor. Spend a night here. (BLD)

Hotel: Scandic Hotel Copenhagen or similar

**Day 13/Feb 27 COPENHAGEN/MANILA**

Morning is at leisure for your own activities until transfer to the airport for your flight back home. (B)


