**Day 01/Nov 04 MANILA/ ROME**

**Day 02/Nov 05 ARRIVE ROME**

Arrive in Rome, the Eternal City and declared "European Capital of Culture". Proceed to sightseeing. View the **Coliseum** site of gladiatorial combats and early Christian martyrdom, **Roman Forum, Piazza Navonna, the Spanish Steps**, among others. Proceed to nearby Mestre for accommodation. (B,D)

**Day 06/Nov 09 VENICE/SALZBURG, Austria**


