Day 01 MANILA / CAPETOWN

Day 02 CAPETOWN

Welcome to South Africa. Arrive in spectacular Cape Town, also known as the “Mother City”. Situated in the southwestern tip of Africa, Cape Town and the Western Cape are recognized as one of the most beautiful on earth offering a range of attractions, breathtaking sights, friendly people, a mild climate and rich cultural heritage. Begin with a cable car ride to the top of **Table Mountain** for breathtaking views of the city, the ocean and Cape Peninsula. (if weather permits). Check in to your hotel. (L/D) Hotel: Commodore Hotel or similar

Day 03 CAPETOWN

Day 05 CAPETOWN/JOHANNESBURG

Transfer to the airport for your flight to Johannesburg. Head to Pretoria for sightseeing with visits to historical sites, such as the Voortrekker Monument, the Union Buildings, Kruger House and Church Square. You’ll admire the spirit of the Africaners who discovered and built this nation. Continue your journey to Sun City, otherwise known as “The City That Never Sleeps”. For several years, this city played host to the Miss World competition in a bid to attract tourism. (B/L/D) Hotel: Palace of the Lost City

Day 06 SUN CITY

The rest of the day is for your own activities. An exciting day awaits you! Today, discover the many myths and legends from Africa’s distant past, which surround The Lost City, a photographer’s dream come true with its magnificent ancient architecture and beautiful landscapes. For those who would like to try their luck in winnings, there are many casinos. For sport enthusiast, enjoy a game of golf at any one of the two championship courses or try watersports of any form imaginable at Waterworld, a man-made lake. Lunch and dinner will be at the hotel restaurant. (B/L/D)

Day 07 SUN CITY/JOHANNESBURG

Drive to Lanseria to visit the **South African Lion Park**. Guest will have a 30-minute interactive experience with lion cubs and they can also walk around and view other indigenous young animals like cheetah, hyena, leopard, caracal as well as the ever-popular and rare white lions. Then proceed to nearby **Lesedi Cultural Village** for the memorable cultural experience. Enjoy a special African meal at **Carnivore Restaurant**. They serve, giraffe, hippo, impala, kudu, zebra, ostrich and warthog meat. Soup comes in potjie pot and Masai swords are used in carving “all the meat you can eat!”. Chairs covered in zebra skin and African cooks in boosters and striped aprons are all a part of **“The World’s Greatest Eating Experience”**. Definitely for gourmets. Overnight in Johannesburg. (L/D) Hotel: Holiday Inn Hotel Sandton or similar

Day 08 JOHANNESBURG/MPUMALANGA

Leave for Mpumalanga area. A guided tour of **Panoramic Route** : The **Blyde River Canyon** and **Three Rondavels** to see spectacular views of the 3rd biggest canyon in the world. Then to **Lisbon Falls**, South Africa’s Lowveld. Spend the night in Hazyview. (B/L/D) Hotel: Perry’s Bridge Hollow Boutique Hotel or similar

Day 09 MPUMALANGA/KARONGWE GAME RESERVE

Visit Maoholoholo Wildlife Rehabilitation Center, home to many of South Africa’s abandoned, injured and poisoned wildlife. The center is extremely proud of its efforts in wildlife education in South Africa. Continue to **Karongwe Game Reserve**, an untamed garden of Eden where the spoor of wildlife invites you to explore the timeless beauty of the bush; an oasis of unimaginable luxury provides the greatest vantage point to the Big Five and its vast, untouched wilderness. Karongwe Game Reserve is a 21000 acre wildlife paradise straddled between four rivers and is located just 45 minutes from the world famous **Kruger National Park**. Later afternoon game drive. Most of the rangers and trackers are Shangaan and bring to the game experience the richness of their culture and vast knowledge of nature. With their natural tracking abilities and Karongwe Game Reserves modern bush telegraph, the rangers will go out of their way to bring you as close to the Magnificent Seven (lion, leopard, elephant, buffalo, rhino, cheetah, and African wild dog) as they possibly can. Lunch and BOMA will be enjoyed at the lodge. (B/L/D) Lodge: Shiduli Private Game Lodge or similar

Day 10 KARONGWE GAME RESERVE/JOHANNESBURG

Early morning game drive. Check out and drive back to Johannesburg for the night. (B/L/D)

Day 11 JOHANNESBURG/MANILA

Morning sightseeing of the city before we continue to the airport for your flight back home or extension to Botswana and Zimbabwe. (B)

Day 12 ARRIVE IN MANILA

Extension: BOTSWANA AND ZIMBABWE

Day 11 JOHANNESBURG/KASANE,Botswana

Transfer to the airport for your flight to Kasane, Botswana. Enjoy high tea at the lodge. This afternoon, we take a **boat cruise** along the beautiful Chobe River. Elephants, hippo and many bird species can be viewed from the boat while we watch another glorious African sunset. (B/L/D) Hotel:The Cresta Mowana Safari Resort & Spa or similar

Day 12 CHOBE NATIONAL PARK/ VICTORIA FALLS

Early morning wake up call for a guided 4 x 4 Safari Game drive and enjoy the Chobe National Park Game for viewing experience Chobe River forms a border between Botswana and Namibia and Zambia. Chobe is one of Botswana’s premier game parks, renowned its large elephants herds. Back to the lodge for breakfast then check out to transfer to Zimbabwe. Arrive at the Kazungula Border. Continue to **Victoria Falls Town**. Named after the famous World heritage Site and Water Falls, the town of Victoria Falls is situated on the Zambezi River and surrounded by the Victoria Falls National Park. Guided sightseeing then to your accommodation. Join the **Sundowner Cruise** passing through the Length of the “Mosi-Oa-Tunya National Park”. (B/L/D) Hotel: The Kingdom Hotel or similar

Day 13 VICTORIA FALLS

Guided tour of Victoria Falls (Zimbabwe side) to discover the beauty of nature and the biggest waterfalls in the world. Back to the lodge for some rest. In the evening you will enjoy dinner at the world famous BOMA Restaurant. (B/L/D)
