Day 01/May 25 MANILA / JOHANNESBURG

Day 02/May 26 JOHANNESBURG/PRETORIA/SUN CITY
Welcome to Johannesburg. Head to **Pretoria** for sightseeing with visits to historical sites, such as the Voortrekker Monument, the Union Buildings, Kruger House and Church Square. You'll admire the spirit of the Africaners who discovered and built this nation. Continue your journey to Sun City, otherwise known as "The City That Never Sleeps". For several years, this city played host to the Miss World competition in a bid to attract tourism. (LD)

Day 03/May 27 SUN CITY
The rest of the day is for your own activities. An exciting day awaits you! Today, discover the many myths and legends from Africa's distant past, which surround The Lost City, a photographer's dream come true with its magnificent ancient architecture and beautiful landscapes. For those who would like to try their luck in winnings, there are many casinos. For sport enthusiasts, enjoy a game of golf at any one of the two championship courses or try watersports of any form imaginable at Waterworld, a man-made lake. Lunch and dinner will be at the hotel restaurant. (BLD)

Day 04/May 28 SUN CITY/MABULA GAME RESERVE
After breakfast, drive to a game lodge. An exciting game drive awaits you. Mabula Game Reserve is situated in Limpopo. It has spectacular scenery and rich vegetation comprising bushveld plains, surrounded by wooden hillsides and unspoiled ravines that are haven to **the Big Five** as well as a large variety of other wildlife. Day 05/May 29 MABULA/JOHANNESBURG

Chairs covered in zebra skin and African cooks in boaters and striped aprons are all a part of "The World's greatest eating experience." Definitely for gourmets. Overnight in Johannesburg. (BLD) Hotel: Hotel Sandton or similar

Day 06/May 30 JOHANNESBURG/GEORGE/KNYSNA
Transfer to the airport for your flight to George, the sixth oldest town in South Africa. It lies at a junction along the Garden Route where the main

road continues along the coast. Today, George is a modern town with a sophisticated infrastructure.

Head towards an **Ostrich Farm** for lunch and a guided tour to learn about these fascinating birds, from the history of ostrich farming to its breeding and rearing. Get you souvenirs. On to the renowned **Cango Caves**, one of the World's Great natural wonders. A guided visit through the caves. Continue to Knysna, situated between lush forests and the shores of a peaceful estuary. Visitors are spoilt with a kaleidoscope of unforgettable experiences. Some time for shopping or walk around the Knysna waterfront. (BLD) Hotel: Premier Hotel Knysna or similar

Day 07/May 31 KNYSNA
Transfer to Plettenberg Bay. Enjoy the Ocean Blue marine Excursion. Back to the harbor for a sumptuous seafood lunch. Continue to visit the Monkey Land & Birds of Eden Sanctuaries. Day 08/Jun 01 KNYSNA/STELLENBOSCH/CAPETOWN
Drive to Stellenbosch to visit a wine estate for wine tasting. Time at leisure or shopping here. Arrive in spectacular Cape Town, also known as the "Mother City". Situated in the southwestern tip of Africa, Cape Town and the Western Cape are recognized as one of the most beautiful on earth offering a range of attractions, breathtaking sights, friendly people, a mild climate and rich cultural heritage. Finally head towards the V& A waterfront for some shopping. A must is a visit to a Diamond Workshop which Africa is noted for. (BLD) Hotel: The Lagoon Beach Hotel or similar

Day 09/Jun 02 CAPE TOWN
See for yourself how this spectacular southern tip of Africa became known as the "Fairest Cape"; one of the five most beautiful ports in the world, the others being Hong Kong, Sydney, Rio de Janeiro and San Francisco. Begin with a cable car ride to the top of **Table Mountain** for breathtaking views of the city, the ocean and Cape Peninsula.

Drive by the historical **Malay Quarter**- this area of narrow cobblestone streets and mosques is notable for its distinctive architectural style; the House of Parliament, the City Hall and the **Castle of Good Hope** – restored fort of Cape Town. Back to V & A Waterfront to enjoy a Sunset Cruise. (BLD)

Day 10/Jun 03 CAPE TOWN
Full day tour of the **Cape Peninsula**. Drive down the Indian Ocean coastline through the famous resort of Muizenburg, Fishhock, and historic Simonstown. Tour **Boulder's Beach** to gleefully see the penguins. Arrive at Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve before reaching **Cape Point** and ascend to the highest point. Witness the "Meeting of Oceans" (The Indian and Atlantic Oceans). A sumptuous lobster lunch awaits you.

Day 12/Jun 05 THE CHOBE NATIONAL PARK/ZAMBEZI RIVER/VICTORIA FALLS
Early morning wake up call for a guided 4 x 4 Safari Game drive and enjoy the Chobe National park Game for viewing experience Chobe River forms a border between Botswana and Namibia and Zambia. Chone is one of Botswana's premier game parks, renowned its large elephants herds. Back to the lodge for breakfast then check out to transfer to Zimbabwe. Arrive at the Kazungula Border.

Continue to Victoria Falls Town. Named after the famous World Heritage site and Water Falls, the town of Victoria Falls is situated on the Zambezi River and surrounded by the Victoria Falls National Park. Guided sightseeing then to your accommodation. (BLD)
Hotel: The Kingdom Hotel or similar

Day 13/Jun 06 VICTORIA FALLS
Guided tour of Victoria Falls (Zimbabwe side) to discover the beauty of nature and the biggest waterfalls in the world. Back to the lodge for some rest. Join the Sundowner cruise passing through the Length of the "Mosi-Oa-Tunya National park". In the evening you will enjoy dinner at the world famous BOMA Restaurant. (BLD)




