Day 01/Oct 09 MANILA/LISBON

Day 02/Oct 10 LISBON, Portugal

Arrive in Lisbon, capital of Portugal. Lisbon is a city of pastel colors and cobblestone streets, of vistas and monuments. After immigration customs formalities, drive to the city for a Eucharistic Celebration at St. Anthony's Church. Remember St. Anthony, one of the few doctors of the church, was born here Overnight in Lisbon. (D)

Day 03/Oct 11 LISBON/SANTAREM/FATIMA or nearby city

Visit the **Jeronimos Monastery** and the **Belem Tower** (exterior) both good examples of the 16th century Manueline style, and finally the **Monument to the Discoveries**. Depart to **Santarem**, one of the oldest cities in the world. Walk through its narrow streets to the Church of St. Stephen, containing the oldest recorded Eucharistic miracle. Continue to Fatima or nearby place for accommodation. Right now, we can get hotel in Saldas Da Rainha. (BD)

Day 04/Oct 12 FATIMA/COIMBRA/FATIMA

Drive to **COIMBRA**, city that houses the oldest university of Portugal. Walk through the streets of Coimbra, until the Convent of the Carmelites, where has lived and died Sister Lucia, one of the little shepherds of Fatima. Rest of the day is for private devotions. Participate in the Rosary and candlelight procession. (BD)

Day 05/Oct 13 FATIMA

Today is the 100th anniversary of the Fatima apparitions. Jubilee routes has four stations with respective prayers. **Centennial Portico** (Prayer of the Apostolic Creed), **Chapel of the Apparitions** (Prayer of the Rosary), **Tombs of the Little Shepherds** (Prayer of the Rosary) and **Chapel of the Most Holy Sacrament** (Prayer for Peace). Visit the humble homes of the visionaries and realize their humble living then. Rest of the day is for private devotions. (BD)

Day 06/Oct 14 FATIMA/SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA, Spain

Continue to TUI, where another apparition happened. Spend the night in nearby **PONTEVEDRA** where an apparition of Fatima also happened.

Head towards **Santiago de Compostela**, the world's third traditional pilgrimage center and "Cultural Capital of Europe". Spend the night here. (BD)

Day 07/Oct 15 SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA

During medieval times, thousands of pilgrims from all over Europe trekked on foot to this center of miracles. There's a distinct mystic ambiance around you'll evidently feel. A most impressive **Cathedral** stands over where the tomb of the **Apostle St. James** was discovered. Since the discovery of his tomb, numerous petitions have been favorably reported here. Eucharistic Celebration. Rest of the day is at leisure. (BD)

Day 08/Oct 16 SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA/AVILA

Drive to the walled city of Avila. Rest of the day is at leisure. (BD)

Day 09/Oct 17 AVILA/MADRID

Hear about the life of **St. Teresa**, Doctor of the Church and one of the greatest figures in Church history. Eucharistic Celebration. Continue to Madrid, one of the most beautiful cities in the world: imposing, elegant! Drive past the fabulous **Royal Palace**, one of the most impressive palaces in the world. See **Puerta del Sol**, **Plaza Espana** with its monument to Cervantes, the Parliament, then to the grand **Cibeles Fountain** plus imposing Alcala. Rest of the afternoon is at leisure. (BD)

Day 10/Oct 18 MADRID/ZARAGOZA

Drive to Zaragoza, historic residence of the former kings of Aragon. Overlooking the Ebro River in the city center is baroque the miraculous **Nuestra Señora del Pilar basilica**, a famous pilgrimage site with a shrine to the Virgin Mary and multiple domes. Mudéjar-style landmarks, combining Islamic and Gothic architecture, include the Aljafería, an 11th-century Moorish palace, and the Cathedral of the Savior, begun in the 12th century. Spend the night here. (BD)

Day 11/Oct 19 ZARAGOZA/LOURDES, France

Visit the huge Basilica of the miraculous **Nuestra Senora del Pilar**. Zaragoza is famous for its amazing food, fine examples of Mudejar architecture, that are now part of a World Heritage site, the **Aljaferia Palace**, and a number of stunning churches

and cathedrals. Don't forget to find some of Zaragoza's amazing modern wall murals that are scattered all over the city.

Up to the Pyrennes and arrive in Lourdes. Little by little snow appears. After dinner participate at the most moving and inspiring candlelight procession. (BD)

Day 12/Oct 20 LOURDES

Eucharistic Celebration. Drop your petitions. You may wish to bathe in the miraculous water. You'll be immensely inspired by the humble life of Saint Bernadette. Perhaps watch a movie on her life. Pray collectively before the life-size Stations of the Cross in its most magnificent setting. Witness the Blessing and Procession of the Sick! Now meditate at the Grotto for a close communication with God. (BD)

Day 13/Oct 21 LOURDES/PARIS

Depart for Paris via the TGV fast train. Enjoy a delightful cruise along the River Seine passing by majestic landmarks.(BD)

Day 14/Oct 22 PARIS/LISIEUX/PARIS

Drive to picturesque Lisieux, home of St. Therese of the Little Flower. St. Therese whom Pope Pius X called "the greatest saint of modern times". Her extraordinary love for God and devotion to humanity come alive as you visit the very impressive Basilica of St. Peter, the museum containing her relics and Les Buissonets, her family home. Combine your prayers in the Carmel chapel with those of the Carmelite sisters, just as St. Therese did before her death in 1897. Eucharistic Celebration. Back to Paris for another night. (BD)

Day 15/Oct 23 PARIS

Eucharistic Celebration at the **Shrine of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal** where you'll pray afterwards before the incorrupt body of St. Catherine Laboure. Proceed to sightseeing. Visit the Cathedral of Notre Dame, one of the greatest Gothic churches in the world with its magnificent stained glass windows. See the majestic Arc de Triomphe, Champs Elysees, Place de Concorde, one of the most admired plazas in the world. Up to the second level of Eiffel Tower, up, up for a scenic view of the loveliest city in the world. Rest of the day is at leisure. (BD)

Day 16/Oct 24 PARIS/MANILA

Rest of the day is at leisure until transfer to the airport for your flight back home. (B)
