Day 01 / Sep 05 MANILA/TASHKENT

Day 02/ Sep 06 TASHKENT, Uzbekistan
Arrive Tashkent in the morning. After immigration and customs formalities, start sightseeing. Visit Amir Temur Square, monument of great commander- Amir Temur the well known Tashkent chiming clock and Hotel Uzbekistan, the Palace Forums "Broadway"- avenue of artists and inexpensive souvenirs exposed for sale and also fountains and modern monuments of the capital. Overnight in Tashkent. (D)

Day 03 / Sep 07 URGENCH & KHIVA
Transfer to airport for flight to Urgench. Marvel at the impressive wall surrounding the city. Visit the Ichan-Kala architectural complex(XII-XIX). Visit the residence of the last Khiva Khan including the Ismail Khodja Mausoleum, Muhammed Amin Khan Madrassah and other Khiva tourist sights. After dinner fly back to Tashkent. (BLD)

Day 04/ Sep 08 TASHKENT/BUKHARA
Transfer to airport for your flight to Bukhara. Sightseeing will include a visit to Citadel Ark (4th c. BC), Samanides Mausoleum (9-10th c.), Chashma Ayub(14th c.), Bolo-Hauz Mosque (beginning of the 20th c.) Coumpol bazaar, Medresseh Nodir-Divan-Beghi, complex Lyabi-Khauz (14-17th c.), Minaret Kalon (12th c.), Kalyan Mosque (12th c.), Medreseh Miri Arab (16th c.). Overnight in Bukhara. (BLD)

Day 05 / Sep 09 BUKHARA/SAMARKAND
Transfer to the railway station to Samarkand. Sightseeing will include a visit to Registan Square- Medreseh Ulughbek(15th century) Medreseh Shir-Dor (17th century) Medreseh Tilla-Kori (17th century) Bibi -Khonum Mosque,

Architectural complex Shahi-Zindeh (11-15th century). Spend the night here.(BLD)

Day 06 / Sep 10 SAMARKAND/TASHKENT
Visit the Mausoleum of Guru Emir-Tamerlanes Tomb (14th-15th century) Imam Al Bukhariy Memorial Complex. Excavations and museum of the ancient city of Afrosiab. Lunch at a local restaurant. Transfer to railway station for evening train to Tashkent. (BLD)

Day 07 / Sep 11 TASHKENT/ALMATY, Kazakhstan
Transfer to the airport for your flight to Almaty (Kazakhstan) . After immigration and customs formalities, proceed to your hotel for accommodation. Some free time at leisure. (BLD)

Day 08 / Sep 12 ALMATY
Take a cable car up to **Kok Tobe mountain**. Kok-tobe is a mountain on the south-eastern outskirts of Almaty with the elevation of 1130 meters above sea level. Excursion to the State Natural National Park Ile-Alatau and visit the Medeo Gorge. Medeo is an outdoor speed skating and bandy rink . It is located in the mountain valley (Medeo Valley or the Malaya Alma-Atinka River). Later visit the Big Almaty lake to see the Eagle Farm. Dinner and back to hotel. (BLD)

Day 09/ Sep 13 CHARYN CANYONS excursion
Full day excursion to Charyn Canyons. Back Almaty for the night. (BLD)

Day 10 / Sep 14 ALMATY
Sightseeing of Almaty. Visit Panfilov Park where you can see the Zenkov Cathedral constructed between 1904 and 1907 by the bishop of Turkestan and Tashkent also one of the highest buildings in the World, War Memorial, National Museum, and New Republic Square where you can see the Independent Monument. This was dedicated to the Republic of Kazakhstan's rich history from the time of Queen Tomiris to the present day. After dinner transfer to the airport for your flight to Manila via Bangkok. (BLD)

Day 11/ Sep 15 ALMATY/BANGKOK/MANILA
Arrival in Manila.

Bangkok Extension:

Day 11/ Sep 15 ALMATY/BANGKOK, Thailand
Arrive in Bangkok. Meet and transfer to hotel for accommodation. Free time for own leisure. (B)

Day 12/ Sep 16 BANGKOK
After breakfast, proceed to sightseeing. Visit Damnoensaduak Floating Market. On board the paddle boat, you'll cruise along the canals and experience the way of Thai Living on the both sides of canal bank and enjoy shopping local Thai products and souvenir. Transfer to SANPHRAN ELEPHANT ZOO to watch Elephant Theme show then international buffet at the park.

Back to Bangkok to visit the ART IN PARADISE, the 3D interactive art museum. Get together at the meeting point then transfer to the dinner at KUANG SEAFOOD Restaurant. After dinner, proceed to SIAM NIRAMIT, the must see show of Thailand. Another night here. (BLD)

Day 13/ Sep 17 BANGKOK/MANILA
Transfer to the airport for your flight back to Manila.
