Day 01/Apr 20 DEPART MANILA

Depart Manila.

Day 02 /Apr 21 ARRIVAL TASHKENT

Buffet breakfast. Morning visit Tashkent: Visit Amir Temur Square, monument of great commander- Amir Temur the well known Tashkent chiming clock and Hotel Uzbekistan, the Palace Forums "Broadway"- avenue of artists and inexpensive souvenirs exposed for sale and also fountains and modern monuments of the capital. Dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight in Tashkent.

Day 03/Apr 22 TASHKENT/URGENCH/KHIVA

Buffet breakfast. Transfer to airport for flight to Urgench airport. Meet and transfer to Khiva for accommodation. You'll Marvel at the impressive wall surrounding the city. City tour of Khiva, visit the Ichan-Kala architectural complex(XII-XIX). Visit the residence of the last Khiva Khan including the Ismail Khodja Mausoleum, Muhammed Amin Khan Madrassah and other Khiva tourist sights. Dinner at a local restaurant. Free time . Overnight at hotel. (B,L,D)

Day 04/Apr 23 KHIVA/BUKHARA

Buffet breakfast. Transfer to airport for flight to Bukhara. Arrival in Bukhara . Meet and check in at the hotel. After lunch take the city tour in Bukhara visit Citadel Ark (4th c. BC), Samanides Mausoleum (9-10th c.), Chashma Ayub(14th c.), Bolo-Hauz Mosque (beginning of the 20th c.) Coumpol bazaar, Medresseh Nodir-Divan-Beghi, complex Lyabi-Khauz (14-17th c.), Minaret Kalon (12th c.), Kalyan Mosque (12th c.), Medreseh Miri Arab (16th c.). Dinner at a local restaurant. (B,L,D)

Day 05/Apr 24 BUKHARA/SAMARKAND

Buffet breakfast. Transfer to the railway station to Samarkand. Meet and check in at the hotel. After lunch city tour of Samarkand. Visit Registan Square-Medreseh Ulughbek(15th century) Medreseh Shir-Dor (17th century) Medreseh Tilla-Kori (17th century) Bibi –Khonum Mosque, Architectural complex Shahi-Zindeh (11-15th century). Dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight here. (B,L,D)

Day 06/ Apr 25 SAMARKAND/TASHKENT

Buffet breakfast. Morning visit Mausoleum of Guru Emir-Tamerlanes Tomb (14th-15th century) Imam Al Bukhariy Memorial Complex. Excavations and museum of the ancient city of Afrosiab. Lunch at a local restaurant. Transfer to railway station for evening train to Tashkent. Dinner at a local restaurant. Check in at the hotel in Tashkent. (B,L,D)

Day 07/ Apr 26 TASHKENT/ALMATY(Kazakhstan)

Buffet breakfast. Transfer to airport for your flight to Almaty (Kazakhstan) . Meet and transfer to hotel. Free time. Dinner in the hotel. (B,L,D)

Day 08/ Apr 27 ALMATY

Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to Kok Tobe mountain via cable car. Kok-tobe is a mountain on the south-eastern outskirts of Almaty with the elevation of 1130 meters above sea level. Excursion to the State Natural National Park Ile-Alatau and visit the Medeo Gorge. Medeo is an outdoor speed skating and bandy rink . It is located in the mountain valley(Medeo Valley or the Malaya Alma-Atinka River) . Later visit the Big Almaty lake to see the Eagle Farm. Dinner and back to hotel. (B,L,D)

Day 09/ Apr 28 ALMATY /CHARYN CANYONS

Breakfast at the hotel. Full day excursion to Charyn Canyons. Transfer back to hotel for accommodation.(B,L,D)

Day 10/Apr 29 ALMATY

Morning city tour . Visit to Panfilov Park where you can see the Zenkov Cathedral constructed between 1904 and 1907 by the bishop of Turkestan and Tashkent also one of the highest buildings in the World , War Memorial, National Museum,

and New Republic Square where you can see the Independent Monument . This was dedicated to the Republic of Kazakhstan's rich history from the time of Queen Tomiris to the present day. After dinner transfer to airport for your flight to Manila via Bangkok. (B,L,D)

Day 11/Apr 30 ALMATY/BANGKOK/MANILA

Arrival in Manila.

Bangkok Extension:

Day 11/Apr 30 ALMATY/BANGKOK

Depart Almaty . Arrival in Bangkok. Meet and transfer to hotel for accommodation. Free time for own leisure. (B)

Day 12/May 01 BANGKOK

Breakfast in the hotel. Assembly at the lobby and proceed to Damnoensaduak Floating Market. On board the paddle boat, you'll cruise along the canals and experience the way of Thai Living on the both sides of canal bank and enjoy shopping local Thai products and souvenir. Transfer to SANPHRAN ELEPHANT ZOO to watch Elephant Theme show then international buffet at the park. Transfer back to Bangkok to visit the ART IN PARADISE, the 3D interactive art museum. Get together at the meeting point then transfer to the dinner at KUANG SEAFOOD Restaurant. After dinner, proceed to SIAM NIRAMIT, the must see show of Thailand. Then back to hotel for overnight. (B,L,D)

Day 13/May 02 BANGKOK/MANILA

Breakfast in the hotel. Transfer to airport for your flight back to Manila.


